

I acted extensively for Theatre, TV & Radio and enjoyed it. And later I started directing stage plays and TV films and TV Serials. Now I love both of the professions".

Adding some flavour to the story, Khan said that he had to leave the

dream city because of the unavoidable circumstances. "I was in Mumbai for two years. I acted in some serials. I had few meetings with film directors for few assignments but I couldn't make it as I didn't stay there for a long time due to some domestic issues at my home in Kashmir and I had to return back"

He is the first filmmaker of the valley, who produced & directed documentaries for UGC's countrywide classroom through AVRC of Kashmir University. He is the founder and director of 'Kashmir World Film Festival' – a first of its kind and magnitude in Kashmir. He is also working as Consultant with

North Zone Cultural Centre (NZCC), Patiala at its Srinagar office. He is the Chairman of Actors Creative Theatre (ACT), an organisation, active in the field of Art, Culture, Film & Literature, since 1976.

Khan has been conducting film festivals, theatre festivals, Khan has been conducting film festivals, theatre festivals, theatre workshops, seminars, interactions, discussions and other functions on subjects like art, culture, film and literature involving hundreds and thousands of art loving people, especially youth.

Till date Khan has been felicitated with many awards - Infotel Award" for his meritorious services in the field of "Theatre, Radio & Television", presented by Hon'ble Minister of J&K State, Mohtarma Asiya Nagash (12th Nov. 2017), Was presented "Award of Honour" for his meritorious services in the field of Theatre and Film Making by "All Artists Welfare Association Jammu", presented by State President BJP Shri Sat Sharma and Secretary Academy of Art, Culture and Languages Mr Azeez Hajni (22nd Dec. 2016 at Jammu), Short Film "Sula Mout" directed by him was awarded by J&K Academy of Art, Culture & Languages. He has many achievements to his credit. He has been awarded senior fellowship in the field of folk theatre for a period of two years by Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India (2009 – 2011). Has worked as a subject consultant in the Hindi Feature film "TAHAAN", directed by Santosh Sivan (2007-08). The documentary film titled "KASHMIRI MUSIC" produced & directed by him in 1994 was screened in the International Film Festival, held in Srinagar, organised by Films Division and J&K Academy of Art, Culture & Languages (June 2007) and others.

Mushtaaque has also served as an expert and the judge for his outstanding knowledge regarding the subjects like art and culture. He was an expert in the selection committee of J&K Academy of Art, Culture and Languages, for the selection of Costume designer (Aug. 2006), a member of the panel of Jury in the Painting competition in Kashmir

University (Nov. 2008), a member of the panel of Jury in the Theatre Festival/ Competition organised by ANHAD (Aug. 2009), a member of the panel of Jury in ANHAD's Young Filmmakers Documentary Film Festival (Nov. 2009), was member of the panel of Jury in Folk Theatre festival organised by J&K Academy of Art, Culture & Languages and North Zone Cultural Centre, Patiala (Nov. 2009), was Judge in the 3-day Talent Hunt Programme, held at Bandipore by J&K Academy of Art, Culture & Languages (May 2011), an expert in the Auditions conducted by Song and Drama Division in Srinagar twice (July 2009 & May 2011), a member of the

twice (July 2009 & May 2011), a member of the panel of jury in Theatre Festival organised by J&K Academy of Art, Culture & Languages in Srinagar (July 2013), a member of the panel of jury in the Drama Audition held by Radio Kashmir Srinagar (5th & 6th Aug. 2015), a member of the panel of jury in the Theatre Festival organised by J&K Academy of Art, Culture & Languages in Abhinav Theatre, Jammu (7th to 20th Dec 2015) and an expert for evaluating the plays for Theatre Festival organised by J&K Academy of Art, Culture & Languages in Srinagar (2017).

Being into the profession of filmmaking, Khan asserted that the Bollywood has not explored many destinations in the valley. "Be it for what reasons, but I believe that the film industry has not explored the valley properly. There are many beautiful places that I know personally, where they have not filmed so far and in contrary, I will say that in Kashmir there is a saying that wherever you open your camera, you get a perfect frame"

Explaining about Kashmir World Film Festival (KWFF) Khan's latest venture, he said: "From the past few years, I had a dream of holding a film festival in Kashmir. I was planning for more than a year and finally, in 2017, I did it. The first edition of Kashmir World Film Festival was held in July 2017. In November 2017, we did its second edition and in June 2018 we returned for the 3rd one. Now, we are all set to host its 4th edition in November 2018," Khan said.

"In the festival world, class films and the films from different states of India are screened. The films made on Kashmir get a special emphasis," he

For his initiative of the film festival, Khan has been receiving an overwhelming response and support from all sections of the society and also from the Mumbai film industry. "I kept moving and people kept joining me. My wish is that the KWFF should continue even after my death. I strongly believe in "THE SHOW MUST GO ON," he concluded.



'In Conflict-hit Kashmir, Theatre is not taken seriously'

Mushtaaque Ali Ahmad Khan has donned many hats in his long theatre career. Acting directing, cinematography or play writing—he has not only seen it all but has established himself as a prominent voice in Kashmir's nascent theatre. Mushtaaque sat with Kashmir Narrator's Tariq Ali Mir to talk about his career and the future of theatre in Kashmir. Excerpts:



I come from a very humble and traditional family that had no background in theatre, TV, or films, I had a strong desire of singing from the age of 11 and gradually developed the desire for acting. The only encouragement came from my sister who was pursuing her subjects. She was not allowed to follow her ambitions in music by the family. I got a chance to work in few skits in children programmes of

Doordarshan at the age of 13, and it continued for few years, My mother was very concerned about my studies and wanted me to pursue my higher studies; she did not encourage me in the field of arts. In my university days, I was an active member of the Cultural Club and also participated in few short plays. First role which I got was in a Hindi play titled "Nadi Pyaasi Hai" in this play I had only one dialogue and the play was performed in Srinagar's Tagore Hall, Few

years later, I started working in Doordarshan plays and serial on regular basis.

Who're the artists whose work inspired you to do what you've been doing?

I was fortunate enough to get the love and affection of few gurus in theatre especially Ali Mohammad Lone, Pran Kishore, Kavi Rattan Sharma, M.L. Kemmu, Suraj Narain Tickoo, P.K. Raina, Ashok Jailkhani and Dr. Sohan Lal Kaul. These masters of theatre greatly influenced my learning in theatre and it's from them that I learned the nuances of the art and craft of the theatre.

You are now filmmaker too. How did that happen?

Actually I was into acting for theatre and television. After doing lead roles in a number of success full TV serials I felt stagnated, and in a place like Kashmir there isn't much growth, Then I decided to shift to production and direction. Once I got an opportunity in 1988 to make documentaries, telefilms and serials for Doordarshan My first occumentary film was on power projects of Jammu Kashmir, and my first successful project was telefilm called 'Phirsaal' which I made in 1993. People

remember this film even today.

Tell us about Kashmir World Film Festival (KWFF), your brainchild.

After working as a filmmaker for three decades, I took an initiative of conducting an international film festival in Kashmir on a professional level, This kind of activity was totally missing in this part of the world. For any society it is very essential to have a platform where people can watch meaningful films and do introspection and interaction on different subjects. I had been planning to conduct a film festival in Kashmir from last 7-8 Years.

Do you plan to hold film festivals in the future also?

Of course, Since the response to the first edition of KWFF was overwhelming, we are planning to organise its next edition in the summer or autumn of 2019.

In many conflict zones across the globe, people often take refuge in theatre when bombs rain down, How's the theatre scene in Kashmir which is in the throes of an armed conflict for many decades now?

Unfortunately, the art scene in Kashmir is entirely different from other conflict-hit areas of the world. Strangely, the conflict in Kashmir has not only discouraged but completely prevented theatre activities. The street theatre became even more difficult to perform. Theatre is no doubt a very popular medium to raise the issues of the society, but unfortunately in Kashmir these activities are still not taken seriously by the people. These are considered merely a source of entertainment and amusement.

Thankfully, the fate of our age-old street theatre Bhande Paether has been better. No doubt the artist associated with Bhande Paether faced the onslaught of the last three turbulent decades, but nevertheless survived as an art.

MUSHTAAQUE ALI AHMAD KHAN

Life is a mystery and to live it means to be mystic. Scratch the soil you may find a treasure if not at least you leave a mark of your own. From forensic expert to sketch artist and from the impression on paper to the screen, the wonderful journey of Mushtaaque Ali Ahmad Khan is itself an apt script for a film. Mushtaaque Ali Ahmad Khan is the founder of the International Film Festival by the name and style of Kashmir World Film Festival and many Cultural cum literary clubs of Kashmir. PG in Geography from Kashmir University to film making, transition to many gives the impression of a fairy tale but true to the core for Mushtaaque Ali. Secretary of Cultural Club (of Kashmir University), Chairman of ACT (Actor's Creative Theatre) and a prominent TV actor has created a niche of his own in the field of Acting, Direction, Cultural Activism and set designing. The actor became part and parcel of Doordashan, Srinagar, when there was a galaxy of players around, but Mushtaaque Ali ran off with attention and impressed one and all with pure art, dynamism and above all by his unique style of dialogue delivery. From minor roles to leading roles, the actor director's evolution as a star is a breathtaking story. From forensic laboratories to film sets, from arms to 'takes' and from latitudes and longitudes to dialogue making Mushtaaque Ali managed to turn mega cameras at him. From his old love for arms and ammunitions, the actor opted for negative roles which he played with utmost accuracy. His stature and style helped him to perform on the screen as a villain. Despite limitation at the sets and lack of editing equipment, to play a villain under such circumstances was the real test of wits and guts, but to the one enshrined with potential and passion challenges bow and create a way for the generations to follow. Mushtaaque Ali not only attracted the attention of his admirers but his magnetic personality turned many filmmakers towards him and he was offered roles in Bollywood films that could not materialize for some family reasons. Starting from DAV school and ended at Kashmir University, the actor was fond of music and in the mirror of life, he would look at himself as a police cop. Like others, the classroom was never his area, but at Kashmir University his metamorphosis was on cards for the reason he turned to be politically active student that in reciprocation landed him in jail when he was arrested in 1981 for 8 days. After his release, he continued where he had left. Owing to his outspoken abilities he was elected President of the Geography Department and later he also became Secretary of the Cultural Club of Kashmir University. His acting career has been full of jubilations; the actor was felicitated by the organisation SARHAD, a Pune-based organization in 2019 for his outstanding contribution in organizing Film Festivals in Kashmir. Chinar Art Foundation in 2018 awarded the actor for his contribution in luring people towards Theatre. Infotel Award in 2017, Award of Honour by All Artists Welfare Association Jammu. For directing Sula Mout, Mushtaaque Ali was awarded by the J&K Academy of Art, Culture and Languages in 2015. He was appreciated and later awarded for his films like Ek Afsana Chaman Ka and Tresh Ta Tarpan. For the Stage play, Tagdeer Saaz Mushtaague Ali emerged as a set designer and was awarded for his outstanding innovations in direction and art designing. His set designing was also appreciated in Ek Potli Armanoun Ki, Jheel



Bula Rahi Hai a n d awarded as Best Set Designer. Mushtaaque Ali was adjudged **Best Director** a n d was honored with Shakir and Aslam Memorial Award b v Jhelum Art Media for

directing Tele-film Phirsaal. The actor also won the Best Award and Special Award respectively for plays Bhoma and Juloos. "Deep down the memory lane, almost 40-45 years back a group of young artists in the age of 10-14 years was being booked by me for dramatisation of the series from Indian and western classics. Mushtaaque Ali Khan was one of the main artists who participated in these series. Mushtaaque was too promising in the making of a fine actor in the future times to come. Due to his good physique and husky voice he got preference over others for the lead roles. While recollecting the memories of those days, young Mushtaaque was always obedient, disciplined, and punctual and had the gift of God to act impromptu whenever there was a need." Q:-How from Geography, you ended at Acting and Directing?

Well! There was a kind of pulse within me that I never let go of. It was to present myself before the audience through acting or performing at Theatre. Basically, I started as a singer and started learning from Pt. Shambhu Nath Sopori and Sh. Kaka Ji Safaya, even at University I performed as a singer in many Cultural shows. Geography was my second love, I still believe that acting and direction have given me a name that I cherish. From the earth to ether, the transition witnessed a lot of impediments which I by the grace of Allah managed to tackle. My interest in acting kept me searching for the right kind of platform which finally I found in the form of Theatre, TV and Radio. I consider myself a true music lover because music runs through my nerves. I feel the vibrations all over me whenever music echoes around. Music has widened my horizon, my cosmos and above all, it has multiplied my requirements. It was both my keen concern and appreciation by friends, colleagues, admirers and above all by mentors that guided me through and emerged as an

actor/director. Everyone is an actor I believe, we all have a sort of acting within us that we perform but fail to bring it out and nurse it. I was fast to recognize it and without any further delay I started to feed the seedling of acting within me and that helped. It is very important to grab the opportunity whenever it is available. I have read somewhere that opportunity is like a bottle with a long neck, if you hold it at right time it easily comes under the grip but once you let it go then you need a lot of efforts to hold for the reason its belly keep increasing with the passage of time and once it moves out of your control you have nothing with you save lamentations.



Q:-How difficult it was for you to create a space in the field of acting?

It is true that once you start a career, things are not there to welcome you with open arms, the same is true to me. Initially, it was too tough a job; I at times had a second opinion knocking at my doors vigorously, but then one who is mad to follow his passion, every other thing seems insignificant. I kept my cool and that worked. After initial hiccups and battering, my determination and willpower I should say it proudly came in handy and carved the artist out of the rough stone with odd edges. With time rough edges were polished, sharpness and smartness integrated and above all my incessant hard work aided my talent. One thing I have learned seriously: that hard work has no substitute. One can explore unimaginable depths and heights if one is ready to sweat to make his life sweet. I started acting in skits for the children programme of



Doordarshan, Srinagar, when I was just thirteen years old and worked for two / three years for Doordarshan and then joined 'Yuvavani' Services of the then Radio Kashmir Srinagar as an anchor. Like all other struggling artists, I too faced a kind of hostile atmosphere at home for my mother never

encouraged me for the reason not to compromise the studies. It was how with the passage of time I grew as a mature actor and created a room of my own in the hall of actors, especially in Kashmir. I have in my credit a few basic courses like Film Appreciation Course from FTII (Film and Television Institute of India) besides Basic Videography Courses from the aforesaid institute. You always have to start with the letter 'A' and keep on learning till you find yourself apt to write freely, the same is true to acting. One has to measure his world and act on the responses. I listened to my demands and followed them like a fallen star and finally placed myself in the inn of achievers.

Q:-You have Produced and Directed documentaries for AVRC (Audio Visual Research Centre) University of Kashmir and J&K Tourism Deptt, How different and difficult was this experience?

Working within your own limitations if on one hand is an uphill task but on the other hand limitations teach you more than lavishness. The projects were challenging and tough but then if you know the art of bringing at fore the best of you, difficulties drive you to unknown planes and enrich you to the extent of ending at something hitherto unknown or unheard and the same is true with me. In 1993 I Directed and Produced The Dying Dal Lake and in the same year The Working Children of Kashmir. These projects were really challenging for the reason the atmosphere was hostile and on the other hand, people were in a shell. It was hard to bring them out to face the camera when they were living under a constant psychological trauma. In 1994 Bhand-e-Pather, Kashmiri Music, Sarang, Surnai, Rabab, Kashmir - The Land of Shrines, and Kashmir Ki Ziarat Gahain, were some of the documentaries that I directed and Produced for AVRC (Kashmir University) and J&K Tourism. Apart from these documentaries and short films I Directed and Produced a number of serials and films for DD-Kashir like Phirsaal, Gate, Gaash -e- Tarakh, Ek Afsana Chaman Ka, Tresh Ta Tarpan and Lamhoon Ki Khata. In addition to it, I have in my credit the projects like Power Projects of J&K, Samba Prints, Hindu Temples of Srinagar and a short film on Drug Abuse. Q:-What has been your dream Project so for?

As a Director and Producer, the most enjoyable and remarkable project was a thirteen episode on Ghalib under the title Na Hota Main To Kya Hota for DD Urdu. A 90-minute telefilm on Ghalib titled Tasawwur E Janaan was produced out of the footage of the foresaid serial. Working on such projects is really a challenge for you have to display a legend before



audience in a way you think of him. You have to prove yourself and for that research work must

accurate. These were research-based projects and to maintain the originality of script and narration I met a lot of people who had read and understood Ghalib and tried my best to bring the best out of my research. It was only after such an honest research I was able to do justice to the themes. After thorough research and several recces in states of Dehli, Punjab, Haryana, Rajasthan and UP were visited to suit the location and demand of the script and finally few Palaces were shortlisted in a small town of Western UP known as Amroha, for shooting. At Amroha besides Palaces and narrow lanes, I also got appropriate properties and costumes for the said production.

In 1985, I got a chance to work in a Kashmiri serial Imandar written by Bashir Dada and Directed by Shabir Mujahid. I played a naughty student's role, who later turns into an honest police officer. I played the Protagonist Javaid Khan's role. This drama gave me my screen name Javaid Khan and I am still often addressed as Javaid Khan and people would often ask me to repeat the famous dialogue: "Surikh karay Surikh". Q:-You have been actively involved in 'Kashmir World Film Festival', how has it helped the local film makers?

The objective of the International Film Festival was to screen 'Kashmiribased Films' as well as the selected films from the rest of India and other countries around the globe, under the slogan "Show must go on" to draw together the indigenous filmmakers under one umbrella to provide them International exposure. The last Film Festival till date received 460 films from 15 countries and 111 films from different states were screened and 25 from other countries. 136 films were screened and 30 films were awarded out of which 23 from India and 7 from other countries. 672 students from Kashmir participated in the workshops. Almost 200 delegates graced the occasion besides 15,500 film lovers. I am hopeful that Kashmir World Film Festival (KWFF) shall remain the center of attraction for filmmakers that may in reciprocity encourage tourism to a great extent. No film since 1989 has been screened in the Valley-based Cinema halls and as such, the cinema culture in Valley is history now. To uplift the actors, directors, producers, artists of the Valley KWFF was aimed to encourage them and to address their problems.

Q:-Who honed your skills and abilities as actor director?

It is a difficult question; still, I will try to answer it sincerely. For Television I was brushed up by Sarojini Raina, Basheer Badgami, Jai Kishan Zutshi, Shabbeer Mujahid, Khurshid Masoodi, and for the Radio people who promoted me are Nahida Taj Quraishi, Pran Kishore and Noor Mohammad Lala. The people who always backed up me supported me and boosted me are late Prof. Hamidi Kashmiri, late Jenab Ali Mohammad Lone, late Prof. Abdul Ahad Wani, late Jenab Qaiser



Qalander, late Jenab Ashraf Sahil, Late Jenab Riyaz Geelani, Jenab Mohammad Yousuf Taing, Prof Ab. Ghani Madhosh, Jenab Farooq Nazki, Shri. Vinod Kapoor, Shri. Ajay Mittal, Shri. Kamal Razdan, and Dr. Sohal Lal Koul. I consider myself a product of the above-mentioned galaxy of experts. I have no objection in declaring that they have crafted my personality which I used to put before the audience in whatever role I was offered. The above-mentioned legends have in addition to acting / directing, guided me in all phases of life. Gurus are saints and saints are respected everywhere. I salute all these legends who taught me how to tread on pathways and hilly roads and on wet and dry planes. Whatever I am today I owe and dedicate it to them all. A student must sincerely agree that he is the product of teachers, trainers and critics.

I am highly thankful to Santosh Sivan, Ashok Jialkhani, Farooq Fayyaz, Humayun Qaiser and Ashok Kaul , Kavi Rattan, M L Kemmu and Abdul Ghani for their valuable and value-based suggestion.

Q:-What is the future of upcoming actors of the Valley?

To be honest, I don't see any hope for some genuine reasons: Lack of infrastructure, lack of trainers and above all lack of interest, but there is always the other side of the coin. Half a cup of water to an optimist tells a different tale than the pessimist. For an upcoming actor, it is really difficult under the prevailing circumstance to survive. But having said this I have a strong gut feeling that people may recognize the artist and watch him performing on stage and on both mini and mega screen. There are so many dramatic clubs and societies wherein, an upcoming actor must get an apt environment to groom his potential and personality because there is a thumb role in acting: "Practice under the guidance of Gurus and Perform before the audience". I wish and pray for the young generation to move on despite all odds.

Srinagar: Mushtaaque Ali Ahmad Khan hails from Rajbagh area of Srinagar has left no stone unturned to work for the cause of Art and Culture in Jammu and Kashmir. Besides being a filmmaker Mushtaaque Ali Ahmad Khan is an actor on stage, Radio & Television, who started his career back in 1988.

Born and brought up in Srinagar, Khan has acted in and has directed more than two dozen stage plays. He is one of the leading filmmakers of Kashmir and for the last more than three decades he has produced and directed more than 400 documentaries, telefilms and episodes of serials. He also produced music albums for DD Kashir, DD Urdu, J&K Tourism

Having completed his post-graduation from Kashmir University in 1982, he has also done Research in the 'Eco-Development Project' at Kashmir University (1983). Diploma in Forensic Science (Ballistics) from 'Institute of Criminology & Forensic Science', New Delhi (1984 – 85). Diploma (Hindi) from Central Hindi Directorate (1987 – 88). लगेचच निर्णय घेतला. मात्र, मध्यंतरी करोनामुळे उशीर झाला. गेल्या महिन्यात पुन्हा नवीन तारीख ठरवली अन् आजपासून पुण्यात महोत्सव सुरू होत आहे.

महोत्सवाच्या आयोजनात दिग्दर्शकांचा कसा प्रतिसाद मिळाला ?

आमच्या भागात अनेक उत्तम चित्रपटांची निर्मिती होते. त्यामुळे महोत्सव जाहीर केल्यानंतर दोन आठवड्यांतच आमच्याकडे ८०पेक्षा जास्त चित्रपट आले. दोन चाळण्या करून परीक्षकांच्या समितीने ५४ चित्रपटांची महोत्सवासाठी निवड केली आहे. यामध्ये लघुपट, कल्पनांवर आधारित, वास्तववादी असे विभाग असून, उत्तम चित्रपटांना पुरस्काराने गौरविण्यात येणार आहेत. काही चित्रपट पुणे-मुंबईतील कलाकारांनी तिथे राहून तेथील स्थानिक विषयांवर चित्रित केले आहेत. काही चित्रपटात लेखक, दिग्दर्शक, कलाकार ही मंडळी स्थानिक आहेत. भविष्यात आम्ही दर वर्षी जम्मू-काश्मीरबरोबरच पण्यामध्येही हा महोत्सव आयोजित करणार आहोत.

तुमच्या करिअरची सुरुवात केली; अभिनयाने दिग्दर्शनाकडे कसे वळलात?

मला लहानपणापासून अभिनयाची आवड होती. मात्र, माझा प्रवास उलटा झाला. लोक थिएटरकडून टीव्हीकडे जातात. मी लहानपणी टीव्हीसाठी बालकलाकार म्हणून काम केले, पुढे रेडिओसाठी काम केले. आणि नंतर थिएटरकडे वळालो. ज्येष्ठ रंगकर्मी गिरीश कर्नाड, बादल सरकार यांसह दिग्गजांच्या नाटकांमध्ये मी अभिनय केला. माझी सरकारी नोकरी सुरूच होती. मात्र, अभिनयाची आवड स्वस्थ बसू देत नव्हती. पालकांचा विरोध असूनही मी नोकरी सोडून पूर्णवेळ या क्षेत्राकडे वळलो.

काश्मीरमध्ये उत्तमोत्तम चित्रपटांचे चित्रीकरण झाले आहे. तेथील स्थानिक लोक चित्रपटकलेचे चाहते आणि जाणकारही आहेत. मात्र, जम्मू काश्मीरमध्ये चित्रपट प्रदर्शित करण्यासाठी एकही सिनेमागृह नाही. शहरातील लहान-मोठ्या सभागृहांमध्ये छोट्या पडद्यावर चित्रपट दाखवले जातात. बहुतांश नागरिक टीव्हीवरच चित्रपट बघतात. मी आयोजित केलेला चित्रपट महोत्सवही सभागहातच घेतला होता. त्या वेळी नागरिकांनी आवर्जुन मला जुने लोकप्रिय चित्रपट दाखविण्याची विनंती केली. त्यांना मोठ्या पडद्यावर चित्रपट बघायचे होते, अशी आठवणही खान यांनी सांगितली.

टीव्हीवरील अनेक मालिका, लघुपट, चित्रपट आणि नाटकांत मी हिंदी आणि उर्दूमध्ये अभिनय केला. पुढे दिग्दर्शनाकडे वळालो. ऐतिहासिक, ग्रामीण जीवनशैली मांडणारे, सामाजिक समस्या मला आवडतात. दिग्दर्शन सुरू असताना मी तरुणांसाठी अभिनय, दिग्दर्शनाच्या कार्यशाळा, संगीत महोत्सव आदी कार्यक्रम आयोजित करतो

पणे । कधी दहशतवादी हल्ले. गोळीबार होईल ते सांगता येत नाही, असे अस्थिर वातावरण जम्मू–काश्मीरमध्ये आहे. दहशतवाद्यांनी 1988 सालापासून चित्रपटगृह बंद केली आहोत; तरीही लोकांचे चित्रपटावरील प्रेम कमी झालेले नाही. अशी माहिती गेल्या पाच वर्षांपासून काश्मीरमध्ये आंतरराष्ट्रीय चित्रपट महोत्सव आणि जम्मू-काश्मीर आंतरराष्ट्रीय चित्रपट महोत्सवाचे आयोजन करणन्या मुश्ताक अली अहमद खान यांनी 'लोकमत' शी बोलताना

मनोरंजनाची कोणतीही साधने नसताना, कोणतेच प्रशिक्षण न घेता काश्मिरी तरूण हौसेने मोबाईल अन् छोटया-छोटया कॅमेन्यावर चित्रपट, लघुपट निर्मित करतात, कोणताही परतावा मिळणार नाही हे माहीत असूनही त्यांनी अचंबित हरणान्या आहेत. हा तरूण चित्रपटांमधून खन्या अर्थाने

जम्म—काश्मीरबद्यलची 'पॉझिटिव्हिटी' समोर आणतोय, असेही खान म्हणाले. काश्मीरमधील एका शाळकरी मुलीचा स्कार्फ फाटतो. ती गरीब असल्याने दुसरा स्कार्फ खरेदी करू शकत नाही. एके दिवशी चित्रकला स्पर्धेत विजेव्याला 300 रूपये मिळतील असे जाहीर केले गेले. हे बक्षीस मिळाल्यावर स्कार्फ घेईन, असे तिने ठरविले होते; पण नेमका त्याच दिवशी कपर्यू लागला आणि तिला स्पर्धेला जाता आले नाही. मय ती अपलेच चित्र काढते. चित्रात ती फाअक्या स्कार्फला रंगाने झाकून टाकते. तिथल्या एका शिक्षिकेने केलेल्या या विषयावरील शॉर्ट फिल्माने परस्कार पटकावला.

काश्मीरमध्ये हिंदू—मुस्लीम सलोखा काश्मीरमध्ये हिंदू—मुस्लिमांमध्ये खूप प्रेम आहे. सर्वजण एकोप्याने, आनंदात राहतात. त्यांच्यात एकमेंकांबद्यल द्वेष नाही; परंतु आज खूप चुकीचे चित्र निर्माण केले जात आहे. मी जिथे राहतो तिथे दहा ते बारा हिंदू कुटुंबे राहतात. हो, काही हिंदू काश्मीरमधून स्थलारित झाले हे खरे आहे; पण आजही काही हिंदू लोक तेथे राहतात.

दोन धर्मामध्ये तेढ निर्माण करण्यासाठी फक्त गैरसमज पसरवले जात आहे. मी चित्रपट महोत्सव भरवतो हाणि त्यात एका काश्मिरी पंडिताने तयार केलेला चित्रपटही समाविष्ट आहे, अशा शब्दात खान यांनी काश्मीरमधील हिंदू-मुस्लिम वादावर भाष्य केले.

फिरता महोत्सव आयोजिण्याचा विचार

मुश्ताक अली अहमद खान म्हणाले की, मी स्वतः अभिनेता आणि दिगदर्शक आहे. मी गेल्या काही वर्षात एकही चित्रपट निर्मिती केली नाही; पण गेल्या पाच वर्षापासून काश्मीरमधील लोकांना चित्रपट दाखवतोय, जम्मू-काश्मीरबद्यलचे गैरसमज दूर करण्यावाठी अन् खरे जम्मू-काश्मीर लोकाना कळावे, यासाठी येथील सकारात्मक पैलू, काश्मीरची संस्कृती, कला, जीवनशैली, तरूणांचे विचार महोत्सवाद्वारे लोकापर्यंत पोहोचेविण्याचा प्रयत्न करीत

यापुढील काळात दिल्ली, मुम्बई, कोलकाता यासह देशतील विविध शहरामध्ये फिरता महोत्सव आयोजित करण्याचा विचार आहे. त्यात फक्त जम्मू—काश्मीरशी संबंधित चित्रपट दाखविण्यात येतील.

Reviving Kashmir's past glory



Kashmiri award-winning actor, filmmaker, producer and film festival director Mushtaaque Ali Ahmad, who prefers to call himself a 'cultural activist', was in Pune in the capacity of the director of the Jammu and Kashmir International Film Festival (JAKIFF). The festival, organised by city-based NGO Sarhad, was held for the first time outside the UT.

Khan is also the chairman of one of the oldest cultural organisations, the Actors' Creative Theatre (ACT), since 1983. He worked for the North Zone Cultural Centre (NZCC) for two years as its consultant at its Srinagar sub-office, where he oversaw organisation of festivals, camps and shows on a large scale for the first time in Kashmir. He is also the founder, chief curator and festival director of the Kashmir World Film Festival. He has done this against all odds over the past three decades.

Excerpts from his interview:

Kashmir was once a favourite destination for film shoots. Do you think those days will be back soon?

Kashmir has been the most favourite destination for film shoots of Indian and foreign films. Films were shot in Kashmir even in the last three decades. However, they were very few in number. Around 3-4 films were shot (in a year) during this period. This scenario changed last year. Around 9-10 film crews visited Kashmir for shootings. I can say that the days of the 1960s, 1970s and early 1980s will be back in the near


future. Tourism in Kashmir started booming again in early 2021. Similarly, film shoots are likely to increase.

What is the contribution of Kashmiris to the Hindi film industry?

Kashmiri professionals have been helping film crews from Mumbai and other parts of India in managing and facilitating film shootings in Kashmir. When it comes to the number of Kashmiris in the Hindi Film Industry, it may not be high but it is significant. Starting from KL Saigal, who was the first superstar of Indian cinema, Tabla maestros Alla Rakha and Zakir Hussain, Santoor maestro and music composer Pandit Shiv Kumar Sharma, actors Jeevan, Kiran Kumar, Satish Kaul, Anupam Kher, Mukesh Rishi, Tariq Shah, Parvez Masudi, Mir Sarwar, Ashwath Bhat, Hina Khan, Zaira Waseem, editor and producer Yousuf Bhat, DOP Tasadduq Mufti, playback singer Jaan Nissar, writer and actor Talat Rekhi and a good number of other film technicians have contributed to the Hindi films.

You were the director of the Jammu & Kashmir International Film Festival 2022 held in Pune recently. How was the response to the fest?

It was really a great experience working as a curator and festival director of the first J&K International Film Festival (JAIKIFF) in Pune. It is a wonderful city with warm and friendly people. It was only with the support of such good people that we could organise the festival successfully. The professionals associated with this festival were very cooperative.





